The stream floods in the winter and when there is heavy rain and in the summer it dries up so the effluent will seep into the ground.

I believe that the Environmental Agency require land owners to seek a per mit to discharge sewage into a stream or river has this been applied for?

I am some what perturbed to see that it would appear work is being carried out on this development without planning permission and would urge that the planning officer gives this ma tter his most urgent attention.
