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Community Involvement Statement

We have maintained open and considerate communication with neighbours throughout the development of our small-scale gin business. The single-storey side extension has matching materials to retain the appearance of the existing house and protect the character of the street. It does not affect neighbours' privacy, outlook, light, or access.

The business is not operating. No production has taken place and will not begin until planning permission is granted. When active, all work will remain small batch and confined to the extension. There will be no visitors or on-site sales.

All deliveries and collections will take place through standard domestic courier services. Their frequency will be low and consistent with normal residential patterns, limited to occasional parcels such as bottles, botanicals, or packaging.

We take neighbour impact seriously and remain committed to a quiet, low-profile operation. Neighbours we have spoken to have been supportive of the concept and understand the limited scale. We will continue to keep neighbours informed and respond to any reasonable concerns in the future.
