I have had a letter from Thames water to tell me I have to have a water meter as we are in a water stressed area and it is proposed to build another 79 houses in an area that cannot supply enough water already. To add to that during the winter, or a poor summer, the local sewage has to be removed by tanker, about 6 tankers a day.

The local surgery is over subscribed, the roads, both local and Basingstoke road, are already overcrowded with long tailbacks during the rush hour and if there is an incident on the local, inc.

Basingstoke, road there is chaos on the diversion route, even if signposted as the roads are mainly narrow.

Are there plans to upgrade the water supply system and sewers to cope with the increase in capacity. Likewise with the local roads, are

there plans to widen or even just fill in the potholes that abound in this area?

This estate should not be given permission until the above have been resolved. I have had a problem with water pressure for the past 20 years and it is getting worse as more houses are built in the area, not just in the village.
