To whom it may concern,

I am writing this supportive letter to relay my concerns about the accommodation requirements for my aunt, Mrs Satpal Kaur Vig (DOB 30th July 1944).

Mrs Vig, suffers from a multitude of comorbidities, including: Anaemia of chronic disease, severe osteoarthritis, osteoporosis, Atrial Fibrillation, Heart failure and unilateral visual impairment. Her conditions have resulted in significant limitations with her mobility and she is currently mobilizing with a zimmerframe and aid of 1 or 2 people. She requires assistance from carers throughout the day and recently increased her care package to include overnight carers for her personal care.

My aunt, therefore, requires appropriate changes to be made to her home, to allow for her increasingly demanding care needs, giving her fuller access to all ground floor areas of her bungalow. The bathroom and kitchen facilities, specifically, should be suitably designed to ensure her safety and comfort, during her increasing care requirements.

I am grateful for your timely consideration and would be happy to provide any further support needed, to ensure my aunt is moved back into her home, at the earliest opportunity, with the correct provisions in place, to suit her needs.
