COMMENTS:

The road is not suitable for HGVs, it is regularly used by children as a route to school and I have already witnessed near misses when the entrance is blocked by hgv's turning onto the road. Also the area

surrounding the site is regularly flooded, it's a flood plain by design but imagine the damage to the Charvil Country Park lakes, River Loddon and River Thames if the fuel entered the eco system?

800,000 litres of fuel stored within 10m of the lakes is a disaster waiting to happen. If that 800,000 litres of fuel caught fire, how quickly could Fire Services reach the site as the A3032 is little more than a village residential road.

I feel sorry for anyone living on that road which is already busy having to cope with all the extra noise from hgv's.

This simply isn't a suitable site for Fuel Storage and Distribution and I strongly object to this planning proposal.
