COMMENTS:

I feel I must object to the Speedy Fuel planning application on the following grounds.

1. Charvil is a small parish adjacent to Twyford and is almost entirely residential. Our road infrastructure is not built to withstand the volume of articulated tankers and other fuel carriers on these small roads
2. Concerns that there will be a detriment to wildlife in the country park adjacent to the proposal. Run off and fuel leaks are inevitable and would be disastrous to the wildlife. The land floods often and the fuel leaks would be very difficult to contain.
3. Articulated tankers turning out of the site would encroach on traffic on the other side of the road causing traffic chaos! It is also dangerous and an accident waiting to happen.
4. The fumes from all the extra traffic is detrimental to health, especially those already affected by respiratory illness. A village setting is not the right setting for a business like this.
5. The proximity to residential homes and the possibility of fire/explosion from the storage of large volumes of fuel is not safe.
6. The noise and pollution of vehicles 5am-6pm thundering through village roads would lead to loss of enjoyment, and amenity in our peaceful village .
