**SHINFIELD PARK, WHITLEY WOOD LANE, SHINFIELD, WOKINGHAM, RG2 9FW
SUBMISSION OF DETAILS PURSUANT TO CONDITION 16 OF PERMISSION REF: 250415**

We have been instructed by our client, Wrenbridge (FRELD Reading) LLP ('Wrenbridge') ('the Applicant') to submit details pursuant to Condition 16 of Planning Permission Ref: 250415 which relates to development at Shinfield Park, Whitley Wood Lane, Shinfield, Wokingham, RG2 9FW ('the Site').

Background

Planning permission was granted on 14 October 2025 for the redevelopment of the Site for flexible employment use (Use Class E(g)(ii)-(iii)/B2/B8) together with servicing areas, parking, landscaping and other associated works, including demolition. This permission followed Prior Approval for demolition of existing buildings on the Site, granted on 19 February 2025 (Ref: 250277). Demolition works commenced under the Prior Approval and are now substantially complete.

Wrenbridge have recently procured a contractor for the main build phase and are therefore seeking to discharge relevant conditions on the permission to facilitate works on site. This includes Condition 16 (Landscape Details) to which this application relates.

Condition 16

Condition 16 is split into three parts. This application seeks to expressly discharge parts i) and ii). Part iii) requires compliance only.

Part i) requires full details of both hard and soft landscape works to be submitted to the Council for approval prior to the commencement of development (excluding demolition and groundworks) and lists the following requirements under items a) to l):

- a) Scheme drawings;
- b) Proposed levels and contours;

- c) Hard landscape details/method of installation such as fencing, retaining walls, steps, railings, street furniture etc including detailed landscape drawings installation of hard landscape features including construction in tree root protection areas (as identified within the Arboricultural Impact Assessment dated February 2025 (Ref: 12218_AIA.001)
- d) Detailed design of SuDS features such as Rain Gardens and other SuDs features in accordance with the SuDS Strategy, demonstrating how they will be integrated into the wider landscape allowing them to fulfil amenity, ecological and drainage functions;
- e) Soft landscaping details including planting plans, schedules of plants, noting species, planting sizes and proposed numbers/densities where appropriate;
- f) A Landscape Specification document covering soft landscaping (including site preparation, cultivation, plant handling and other operations associated with plant and grass establishment) and hard landscaping including all construction works such as paths and retaining walls;
- g) Details of the street tree planting pits in combination with the roadside swales/raingardens, and tree planting in soft ground demonstrating that the trees have sufficient rooting volume to enable their successful retention long term health;
- h) Hard landscaping materials including samples;
- i) Minor artefacts and structures (e.g. street furniture, refuse or other storage units, signs, external services) including specifications for the product and its installation;
- j) Specification for tree rooting systems and use of structural soils under paving or where rooting volumes are limited;
- k) All boundary treatments, and other means of enclosure or controlling access such as gates, bollards and vehicle restraint systems, which shall include consideration of ecological permeability; and
- l) Measures required for ecological mitigation and biodiversity net gain.

Part ii) requires details of quality control measures, including supervision of landscape contracts by a suitably qualified landscape specialist and annual landscape audits for the five year period from completion of the landscape works.

Against the above context, we hereby submit the following details for approval:


