**Planning Application:
250063 Warren Crest Farm Wick Hill Lane Finchampstead Wokingham RG40 3PY**

The application site for this proposed development falls within an area of archaeological significance and has potential for Roman and Medieval remains. It is within a Medieval landscape, approximately 500m from the course of a Roman road, and a number of local findspots suggest there may be roadside/nearby activity. Archaeological remains may be damaged by any necessary ground disturbance, therefore you are requested to inform Berkshire Archaeology as soon as possible if any artefacts are discovered. Details of archaeological finds will be added to our Historic Environment Record (HER), an online database of local archaeological sites, finds, and historic buildings within our area, which includes Bracknell Forest, Reading, Slough, Windsor and Maidenhead, and Wokingham.
