Comments:

I would like to express my support for the objections raised by others against this planning application. The grounds for objecting can be summarised as follows:

1. It is an industrial scale proposal to store large quantities of various fuel types in a residential area adjacent to a nature reserve.
2. Traffic – entry to the site is close to a corner which will interfere with the sight lines of other vehicles using the road. This is a particular problem because the proposal will involve large, long transport vehicles which will have to swing out into the opposing part of the road in order to access to and/or egress from the site.
3. The site is prone to flooding. There will be occasions when fuel spillages etc. will have nowhere to go apart from being washed into the River Loddon. This is unacceptable.
4. There are suggestions in the application that biodiversity will be improved. That is simply unbelievable.
5. It is an unacceptable change to the character of the area.
